

JOB SHADOW DRESS CODE

The following dress code will be strictly enforced. If you have any questions regarding this code, please contact Sauk Prairie Healthcare before signing.

Dress in a Manner that Presents a Look of Professionalism

- Participants must dress modestly and neatly with shirt tucked into pants.
- Please avoid extreme dress, hairstyles and jewelry.
- Do not wear clothing such as T-shirts that portrays suggestive or derogatory pictures and messages, including advertising of alcohol, tobacco, etc.
- Clothing should cover all undergarments.
- No sleeveless blouses, shirts or tops.
- Clothing should not be skin tight or revealing.
- The wearing of nose, eyebrow, tongue, lip or body jewelry is prohibited during shadowing hours.
- Body tattoos must be covered during shadowing hours.
- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes no sandals or open-toed shoes.
- Wear dress slacks No blue jeans please.

The Education Coordinator is responsible for evaluating the dress and appearance of all participants. If a participant is not dressed appropriately, they will be asked to leave the program.
